CARE OF YOUR SINGLET

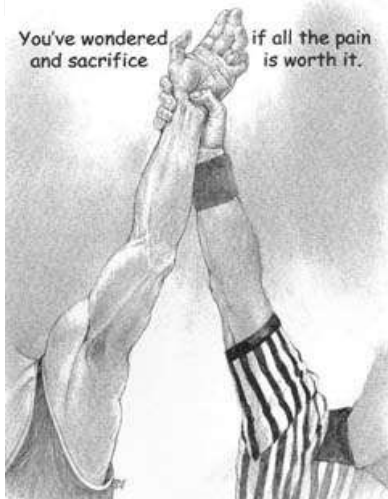
